EUROMEDIC OPENS ITS SEVENTH DIALYSIS CENTRE IN ROMANIA IN PIATRA NEAMT

Euromedic announced the completion of its seventh dialysis centre in Romania in the city of Piatra Neamt. The centre was newly built in the historical region of Moldavia, eastern Romania, which has a population of over 110,000 inhabitants.

IDC Piatra Neamt opened with 161 patients (134 haemodialysis and 27 peritoneal dialysis) that receive treatments on a regular basis. The centre which is part of Euromedic's "Nefromed" chain in Romania is equipped with state-of-the-art haemodialysis equipment and water purification systems. The centre has 35 haemodialysis machines and with a staff of 29 medical professionals will perform over 21,000 treatments annually.

This latest addition extends Euromedic's network of medical centres to 198 (100 Diagnostic, 64 Dialysis, 32 Clinical Laboratories and Two Cancer Treatment Centres) located in 15 countries around Europe.
