EUROMEDIC OPENS A RADIOLOGICAL DEPARTMENT IN THE NATIONAL TRAUMA CENTRE OF HUNGARY



Euromedic announced the opening of its latest state-of-the-art Radiological Trauma centre in Budapest, Hungary. In late 2008, Euromedic won the public tender to provide Trauma related services for the Central Budapest geographical area (700,000 inhabitants) located in Peterfy Hospital one of the largest in the city with over 1,600 beds. This multi-modality centre is Euromedic's 12th diagnostic centre in Hungary.



Budapest Trauma Centre provides a wide range of diagnostic services (7 days a week / 24 hours per day) including: Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), Computerized Tomography (CT), Angiography, Ultrasound, Mammography, X-ray, Radiological Intervention and Nuclear Medicine. The centre headed by Dr. Katalin Bor and her team of 15 medical professionals will complete tens of thousands of Radiological Trauma investigations annually.



With this new centre, Euromedic owns and operates 196 medical centres (99 Diagnostic, 63 Dialysis, 32 Clinical Laboratories and Two Cancer Treatment Centres) located in 15 countries in Europe.
