55 PERITONEAL DIALYSIS PATIENTS TRANSFERRED TO EUROMEDIC'S OUTPATIENT NEPHROLOGY CENTRE IN ZABRZE, POLAND



Peritoneal dialysis can be done anywhere and gives patients more freedom.



Peritoneal Dialysis Kit

A large group of 55 peritoneal dialysis patients have begun treatment in Euromedic's Outpatient Dialysis Center in Zabrze, Poland. It is the largest number of patients of its kind receiving this type of treatment in Poland.

Under normal circumstances the patients will only have to visit the clinic once in 1.5 months and will be able to perform the dialysis treatment in their own homes. Prior to moving to the Euromedic centre, the patients have been under the medical care of Professor Greszczak at "Szpital Kliniczny N1" in Zabrze.

During peritoneal dialysis the patient's own peritoneal membrane serves as a filter and cleans the blood from waste products through the dialysis solution. This dialysis method gives the patient more freedom as all materials are delivered to the patient's home, and there is no need to travel to a dialysis centre 3 times a week.
