EUROMEDIC ACQUIRES 'MEDISCAN' DIAGNOSTIC CENTRE IN BULGARIA IN STARA ZAGORA



Euromedic announced the completion of its acquisition of "Mediscan" Diagnostic Centre in Bulgaria in the city of Stara Zagora (230,000 inhabitants) which is a University town in South Central part of the country.



IMC Stara Zagora is built on the premises of the Central University Hospital and will examine IN/Out patients as well as Trauma emergencies. The University Hospital is the referent for the South-Central part of the country and is equipped with a Computerized Tomography (CT) and a 1.5 T Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) modalities. IMC Stara Zagora is headed by Dr. Mitev and together with his staff of six medical professionals will perform over 6,000 diagnostic investigations annually.



This new centre extends Euromedic's network of medical centres to 188 (93 Diagnostic, 61 Dialysis, 32 Clinical Laboratories and TWO Cancer Treatment Centres) located in 15 countries around Europe.
