HUNGARIAN MINISTER OF HEALTH OFFICIALLY OPENS THE SALGÓTARJÁN CENTRE IN HUNGARY

The Minister of Health of Hungary, Dr. Tamás Székely and Euromedic's President, Mr. Joseph Priel opened last week, the upgraded and modernized Lab-screen Salgótarján multi-modality Radiological Diagnostics Centre. IMC Lab-screen Salgótarján, has been part of the Euromedic Group since August 2008, when Euromedic acquired Labscreen Diagnostics Group (3 centres) from Siemens Hungary. The centre is located in the Salgótarján Regional Hospital and operates 24 hours a day / seven days a week.

The centre is equipped with state-of-the-art modalities including: Computer Tomography (CT), Angiography, Mammography, Ultrasound, Fluoroscopy, Digital X-Ray, and IT and telemedicine facilities.

The upgrade of the centre facilities and modalities are part of Euromedic's expansion of service which provides comprehensive service to our patients under the convenience of a single location. This year the centre is expected to perform nearly 65,000 examinations.
