## **EUROMEDIC WILL ESTABLISH A NATIONAL CANCER TREATMENT CENTRE IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**

The Government of the Republic of Srpska in Bosnia Herzegovina and Euromedic signed a Contract in Banja Luka yesterday on establishing the Centre in the city of Banja Luka. The Contract was awarded to Euromedic after winning the International tender. The duration of the contract will be for a period of 15 years with a possibility of extension for an additional other 10 years.

In accordance with the Contract, Euromedic will construct a new building within the complex of the Clinical Center Banja Luka. The Centre will be initially equipped with 2 linear accelerators and 1 Brachytherapy equipment manufactured by “Varian” and “General Electric” CT/simulator, ultrasound color doppler and digital X-rays.

Prime Minister of the Republic of Srpska, Mr. Milorad Dodik said in a ceremony that “The centre will serve the oncology patients that until now were treated in Serbia and that this centre will enable them to receive the highest level of treatment at home”. He praised Euromedic who is a partner for the government for the last decade in providing high level dialysis service in four centres.
