## **EUROMEDIC AWARDED A FOURTH DIALYSIS CENTRE IN BOSNIA, IN THE CITY OF SARAJEVO**

The Minister of Health for the Republic of Srpska has announced that Euromedic has been awarded the contract for a fourth dialysis centre in Bosnia and Herzegovina, located in the eastern side of the historic city of Sarajevo.

This latest contract for dialysis services between the Government, Health Insurance Fund and Euromedic is for a period of 15 years (through 2023), with an option to extend the contract for an additional 10 years upon its expiration. This state-of-the-art-centre will be built and equipped with 15 dialysis machines and prepared to treat 90 patients on a regular basis.

International Dialysis Centre East Sarajevo is a green field project and its construction will run in parallel with the construction of IDC Laktasi and is scheduled to become operational in August–2008. Currently, Euromedic owns and operates 106 medical centres (65 diagnostic and 41 dialysis) operating in 14 countries around Europe.
