EUROMEDIC OPENS THE FIRST PET/CT CENTRE IN ROMANIA

Euromedic International announced the opening of the first PET/CT Centre in Romania. This latest centre is located in Euromedic's existing multi-modality Diagnostic facility in the Fundeni Hospital in Bucharest. The centre will specialize in nuclear medicine and is equipped with state-of-the-art General Electric PET/CT equipment.

PET/CT (Positron Emission Tomography combined with Computed Tomography) is the most advanced equipment in medical diagnostics. This ultra modern technology can not only show anatomical structures of the body, but also how it works (functional images). This technology will allow doctors to detect cancer earlier and diagnose whether the disease has spread. It will also be able to diagnose Alzheimer's disease at a stage when it can be still controlled by medication and in addition, be able to perform enhanced cardio-logical investigations. The Bucharest centre is the first PET/CT in the country and it will serve both public and private patients.

Euromedic now owns and operates seven PET/CT's in Europe. Euromedic's President in Romania, Dr. Anca Petca said that "by opening this centre Euromedic keeps its tradition to be on the front line of healthcare development in the Country".
